I, _____, the Consignor, (Please Print name) hereby accept and enter into this consignment agreement and agree to abide by the consignment rule of The Garden Gallery, Inc as follows:

1. Upon signing this contract, the Consignor is entitled to have all his/her items that are approved by the Garden Gallery Board placed in the revolving display of the Garden Gallery. The arts or craft items held by the Garden Gallery, Inc. under this agreement will at all time remain the Consignor's property. The Garden Gallery, Inc. is authorized to accept monies on the Consignor's behalf for any work sold and shall subtract from that amount the agreed upon consignment percentage.
2. The Garden Gallery, Inc. reserves the right to limit the number of any kind of item displayed. Placement within the Gallery will be at the discretion of the Gallery's Display Committee, which has the right to refuse to display any item not in keeping with the integrity of the Gallery. The Display Committee will always take consideration for items subject to sun, traffic, and handing exposure to damage.
3. The Consignor, at the time of delivery of items to the Garden Gallery, will present the Gallery with an inventory listing of all items and sales prices to be charged. These prices shall include the consignment percentage due the Garden Gallery.
4. A Consignor desiring to remove the majority of their inventory temporarily or permanently must notify the Gallery Display Committee one week in advance of removal.
5. The Gallery Display Committee reserves the right to request the removal from the Gallery of any items that become shop worn, have not sold over a long period of time, or no longer meet the Gallery's standards. The Consignor agrees to pick up such items within two weeks after notification. If any items have to be shipped back to the Consignor, the Consignor will bear the expense of postage and handling.
6. The Garden Gallery assumes responsibility only for providing fire insurance covering consigned items. The Garden Gallery will use reasonable care in handling items, but it assumes no responsibility for breakage, soiling, or damaging of items. The Garden Gallery also assumes no responsibility regarding loss of items due to theft or vandalism. The Consignor must assume any such losses. All consignors may choose to carry insurance to cover their items for product liability (i.e. should their product hurt, wound, or in some way injure a customer or buyer).
7. Some dusting and cleaning is necessary during each of the consignor's working days and it is wished and appreciated that the working consignor would do so during a time when customers are not present.
8. The Gallery Board Treasurer will issue consignment checks in a timely manner following the last day of June, July, August, September and October.
